Separate sealed bids for construction of Belgrade North Side 4-inch Water Main Replacement will be received by The City of Belgrade at the City Hall until 10:00 A.M. local time on May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

The project consists of two schedules.

Schedule I: includes the construction of 6"-12" diameter water mains, fittings, valves, fire hydrants, water service connections to the new water main, removal, concrete replacement, asphalt and gravel shoulder replacement and miscellaneous items of construction on Hoffman Street, Quaw's Boulevard, Weaver Street, Broadway Street, Kennedy Street, Davis Street, Bridger View Drive, Benson Place, Cameron Avenue, Central Avenue, Allison Avenue and Southview Avenue.

Schedule II: includes the construction of 6"-8" diameter water mains, fittings, valves, fire hydrants, water service connections to new water main, 8"-10" diameter sewer mains, sewer service connections to the new sewer main, concrete valley gutter and approaches, concrete replacement, asphalt and gravel road replacement and miscellaneous items of construction on the Alley between Main Street and Central Avenue.

There will be a **mandatory** Pre-Bid Conference at the City Hall at 10:00 A.M. local time on May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Interested CONTRACTORS are required to attend.

CONTRACTOR and any of the CONTRACTOR'S subcontractors doing work on this project will be required to obtain registration with the Montana Department of Labor and Industry (DLI). Forms for registration are available from the Department of Labor and Industry, P.O. Box 8011, 1805 Prospect, Helena, Montana 59604-8011. Information on registration can be obtained by calling 1-406-444-7734. CONTRACTOR is required to have registered with the DLI prior to bidding on this project. All laborers, mechanics, and plumbers employed by CONTRACTOR or subcontractors in performance of the construction work shall be paid wages at rates as may be required by the laws of Gallatin County, the State of Montana, and the Federal Government. The CONTRACTOR must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

Each bid or proposal must be accompanied by a Certified Check, Cashier's Check, or Bid Bond payable to City of Belgrade, in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid. Successful BIDDERS shall furnish an approved Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials Payment Bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount. Insurance as required shall be provided by the successful BIDDER(s) and a certificate(s) of that insurance shall be provided.

This project is funded in part or in whole with grant/loan funding from: State Drinking Water Revolving Fund.

No bid may be withdraw after the scheduled time for the public opening of bids, which is 10:00 A.M. local time on May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals received, to waive informalities, to postpone the award of the contract for a period of not to exceed sixty (60) days, and to accept the lowest responsive and responsible bid which is in the best interest of the OWNER.
